

ORDINANCE 1039

AMENDING MEMBERSHIP OF PUBLIC WORKS BOARD

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE MILLS, JEFFERSON COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2-8-1-B of the Lake Mills Municipal Code is repealed and recreated as follows:

2-8-1: **ESTABLISHMENT, MEMBERSHIP AND ORGANIZATION:**

B. Membership:

1. The Board of Public Works (Board) shall consist of six voting members, as well as ex-officio members as designated herein.
2. Four of the voting members shall be residents of the City of Lake Mills and shall be appointed to staggered, three-year terms by the City Council President, subject to confirmation by the Council.
3. One of the voting members shall be a Council member who shall be elected to a one-year term by the Council.
4. One of the voting members shall be a resident whose primary residence is served by both city-owned electric and sanitary sewer utilities. Such member shall be appointed to a three-year term by Town of Lake Mills Board of Supervisors. Such member is authorized to vote only on matters relating to the sanitary sewer utility, electric utility, or the governance or operation of the Board.
5. The ex-officio, non-voting members of the Board shall be the City Manager, City Attorney, City Clerk-Treasurer, Electric Utility Superintendent, Streets Supervisor, and Wastewater Utility Supervisor.
6. The voting members shall not receive compensation for their service on the Board. Each voting member shall take the oath required under Wis. Stats. § 19.01, and such oath shall be filed with the City Clerk-Treasurer.

Section 2. This ordinance was sponsored by Council Member Joe Van Tassel.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
